STOUT was a rancher in the Jefferson area according to a vol.in the KS Hist.Soc. in Topeka.

Charles HELLENBRAND in Bangor, ME, emigrated 1858/59 via Golden Rocket around the Horn, joined brother at Eagle Creek for 2 years, 1859-61. May be related to Ira + Amanda KIMBALL, Polk Co., Oregon through William Foster, father, who has some connection at birth (ca. 1790, Argyle, ME) with a Solomon Farnham KIMBALL Jr. Definitely related through dau. of Ira/Amanda> Leona who m. George Washigin NASH came to Oregon between 1885 and 1900. He passed away March 29, 1900. His wife and family are Anna Elizabeth BURNS NASH 1. Charles E. NASH m. Carrie E. KNOTTS; 2. John Burns NASH m. first Laura Geneva MORFORD second Linnie Alice CLARK; 3. Clarence F. NASH m. Margaret H.; 4. Resella Belle NASH m. Clarence E. KNOTTS; 5. William Early NASH m. He died in either Multnomah or Clackamas County. He married Della (Adell) BEEMER. They had several children including my father, Clyde Wesley ADAMS. My father's siblings include, Thelma, Bud, Orville, and Carolyn. Clyde was born May, 1926. Rumor has it that Eddy was a crony of Al Capone's. I would love to know anything I can about Eddy and Della as I cannot even find their parents so that I can move on with my research. Della Beemer was the daughter of a chiropractor who had an office in Warrenton, Oregon.

Mon Sep 1 15:15:35 1997

Hulda (Light) Danielson b. 26 Feb 1871 in Brown Co. MN married Emil Danielson and moved to OR. She is buried in the Miller Cemetery in Woodburn - died 14 Nov 1918 in Monitor, Marion Co. Looking for her sister also - may have died before 1805: Rena (Light) Mortenson b. 21 March 1872 m. Julius Mortenson - also moved to OR. The girls mother died young and the little girls were raised by an uncle and his family in MN.

Thurs. 11 Dec 1997

Louise SCHROEDER. She married William Lewis RAE 13 June 1896 in Portland, and then later, after William died, Samuel BATDORF. Her family was from Stafford, Oregon, had emigrated from Germany. Brothers were Paul, Rudolph, Conrad. Sisters were Lena, Minnie, Hannah, Josephine, and Nettie. Some of the sisters' married names were EISELY, ZIMMERMAN, and perhaps WILKINS. Louise, her infant son, Willis, and some of the Schroeder family are buried in Stafford Cemetery.

I am trying to contact descendents of Charles KELLY originally of Seneca County, New York. His father was also Charles KELLY and his mother was Cornelia GOLTRA. The younger Charles married Elizabeth LATOURETTE, and they moved to Oregon City in Clackamas County at an unknown date. He was born on February 19, 1809, and they were married on January 11, 1827. He died June 7, 1884, presumably in Oregon City.

What was Goodin Station in 1920-21? My paternal grandmother, Lillian (Foshaug) PENNOYER, died at age 22 at Goodin Station, Clackamas County. She came from Aberdeen, WA to a TB sanitarium in Portland which she left 12-15-20. Her death certificate lists dod as 5-15-21 at Goodin Station. A note on the certificate leads me to conjecture that she was cared for by my grandfather's aunt, Lettie (Pennoyer) PHELPS, widow of Casper. Was there a sanitorium at Goodin Station or ? Other Phelps, Pennoyer's? BRYANTS?

Lorenzo Dow CROSS b ca 1822 Stark Co OH. He married Dorcas FAIRMAN 19 Nov 1848 in Lee Co IL. They came over the Oregon Trail with baby son Caleb Erastus and settled in Clackamas County. Second son Harvey E. was born in Canby in 1856. Other children were: Thomas Milton, Elmer Ellsworth, William Adelbert, Truman Dow, Charles Ulysses, Francis A., Jasper Melvin and finally (!) a daughter Martha Jane. Am very interested in finding any descendants of this couple. Dorcas was a sister to my great grandmother Ruth FAIRMAN.

CHASE, Thomas J., is listed in the Pioneer Families of the Oregon Territory, 1850 on page 11 as --CHASE, Thomas J. (Clackamas 90, Sc.1). I am descended from a John CHASE, b 1835 in NY. and have not been able to find his parents. Does the 1850 Oregon census identify children of Thomas?

Oregon pioneers, William Dupee ADAMS and Lucina LOVERIDGE of Molalla, Oregon. Children would include: Mary Elizabeth m. Thomas Stoddard HAMMOND; George V. m. Kate ROBBINS; Lucy E. m. Whitcomb BRIGGS; Frank m. Mary KAYLER; Effie Bell m. Dee ENGLE; and Etta Elvia m. Joe HARLESS.

LOVERIDGE/JEFFERSON. Am looking for the descendants of Emma/Emily LOVERIDGE (b. 1863 Illinois), daughter of William LOVERIDGE & Kate WESTALLI. Emma married John JEFFERSON on March 16, 1886 in Marion Co. They lived in Howell Prarie, then moved to Clackamas County. Three children: Nellie JEFFERSON AUSTIN of Oswego, Katie JEFFERSON VENT of Oregon City and William JEFFERSON of Albany. .

Sabrina RUSSELL who resided in Buteville Clackamas Co., Oregon in 1876. She filed a widow's pension for the war of 1812 on Mar 18 1876 which was denied. She was a widow aged 74 years at the time.

Walter and Matilda (Nelson) HITCHMAN came to Monitor, Oregon with their six children: Albert, Ernest, Mabel, Frank, Arthur and Elmer in late 1892 or early 1893. Another son, Earl, was born to them in Monitor.

Albert married Lorena BARBUR, daughter of Orange Lemon BARBUR who was the brother of A.L. BARBUR (known as Old Man Portland) and Luzetta GURLEY, daughter of Dr. Orrin V. and Ann E. GURLEY. Albert and Lorena had four children: Ancel, Clarence (who owned the bullfrog park in Oregon City), Lawrence (who drowned at age 4), and Eloise. The children of Orange Lemon BARBUR were Silas, Ella, Verna, Nettie, Lorena, Mary, Hobart.

Ernest HITCHMAN married Verna Barbur (same parents) they had one child: Lavern. Mabel HITCHMAN died at a young age and never married. Frank HITCHMAN married Susie HARDY and I have no record of children born to them. Arthur HITCHMAN married but I have no records. Elmer married Ella KEASLEY and a son Natun Toth (called Harold) was born to them. They were divorced and Elmer married Alberta Inez MORTENSON who gave birth to Birdie, Kenneth, Geraldine, Delwyn and Lenella. Alberta was the daughter of Julius Francis MORTENSON and Lorena LIGHT, sister to Hulda LIGHT. Earl HITCHMAN married Minnie BEYNOR and a son Walter was born to them. Walter died at the age of 10. All of these

children were born in either the Clackamas or Multnomah County areas.

Wed 1 April 1998

HARVEY - Robert A. HARVEY d. 1 Jul 1938 and Marguerite I. HARVEY d. 15 Aug 1944. They were living in Metolius Pct in 1920. They had issue Floyd O. b. abt 1905 WA and Lois b. abt 1908 OR.

Thur 2 April 1998

JAMES ELVIN MURDOCK born in Marquam, OR on Jun 23,1888 married LULU MAY LEWIS on Mar 28, 1911 and died in 1958. Parents were JOHN MURDOCK (of the mid-Willamette county) and MARY SKIRVIN.

Mon 20 April 1998

Barney BRIODY (1824-1891) came from Ireland and was in Oregon City prior to 1860. He married Tamer SWETT (1847-1929) in Oregon City in 1865. They had 3 daughters, Sarah Catherine (1867-1907) who married John W. NAILS in 1882; Maria (1869-1934) who married Elmer Stickney in 1882; Theresa (1875-1940) who married Solomon WIGLE, and Frederic BRIODY (1877-?) who married E. Ella P. Adams in 1908. I would like to hear from any of the above's descendants. Tamer's father, Benjamin, died on the Oregon Trail. Her mother, Nancy (JOHNSON) Swett (1805-1901) remarried to Andrew SPROULS of Oregon City.

Fri 8 May 1998

My uncle [Arthur J. (Jerry) HIGGINS] lived in Gresham, Oregon, died June 24, 1984. A nephew, David NICHOLS, was informed and took care of arrangements. In 1939, he had three children. He was married several times. I have a picture of him with Dorothy, (second wife ?). On the back of the picture it says "Taken at Jennings Lodge. Mother's place - Mrs. Irene METZLER.

Mon 11 May 1998

Joseph BENTLEY, William THOMPSON, and Berryman JENNINGS who located around Oregon City in late 1852 where Sarah Jane BENTLEY married William THOMPSON at the home of Berryman JENNINGS. Joseph BENTLEY and most of family removed to Wilson Co. Kans ca 1857, THOMPSON'S migrated to Keokuk, Iowa ca 1855 and JENNINGS remained around Jennings Landing south of Oregon City.
